Welcome to Great Whelnetham!

We are delighted to welcome to Great Whelnetham Primary, our new reception children and their families. Please join us in welcoming: Theo, Cameron, Thallia, Ezmae and Freddie. A warm welcome also to Lilly who joins us in Year 1.

<u>Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM)</u>

The children in Reception, Yr. 1 and Yr.2 will receive a free school meal under the government's universal free school meal scheme. Free school meals (FSM) are different to UIFSM and are available to children of families who are in receipt of certain government credits and allowances. If you think you may be eligible please check the government website on https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals to check the criteria and fill in the relevant form. The school would also receive additional funding to help support your child in other ways such as academic and financial support. If you need any assistance with this then please do contact the school.

Snacks and Water Bottles

Please can you make sure that your child has a **named** water bottle in school. They will need to bring it in every **Monday** and take it home on a Friday to be washed. Children in Years 3-6 are encouraged to bring in a healthy snack to have at break time; children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 are provided with a free school snack of fresh fruit and vegetables.

Uniform and PE Kit

Please make sure that your child has their PE kit in school with all items clearly named. Their PE kit will remain in school until half term (excluding Swans). They will also need a pair of **named** trainers to be kept in school.

Nut Allergy Reminder

Please can we remind you all that because we have a number of children who are severely allergic to nuts that all packed lunches and any snacks sent in from home need to be nut free. You will need to check the ingredients in snack biscuits and bars etc. Thank you in advance for supporting the school over this.

Music Tuition

It is very exciting that this term, children in Owls class will be learning how to play the clarinet! We will be having a

specialist music teacher who will be coming into school every Thursday. We are certain that the children will really enjoy this experience and look forward to attending one of their concerts some time very soon!

Class Welcome to Parents

Class teachers are delighted to welcome parents into their pupil's classrooms on <u>Tuesday 19th September</u>. They will be sharing the routines, expectations and exciting learning experiences for the year ahead.
