KEY REMINDERS

SPELLINGS:

We continue to give weekly spellings for the children to learn at home. The pattern of the week is also being taught and practised each day in school. It will benefit your child if they can practice their spellings for a few minutes each night to help them become spelling experts!

WEEKLY HOMEWORK TASK:

Lots of the children are working incredibly hard on their weekly homework activities. I have been very impressed with the hard work being achieved in the weekly tasks. These tasks are always related to the learning taking place in school and are mostly centred around English and Maths.

Y3 BEDROCK LEARNING:

This half-term we have added an extra homework task for Year 3 children only. Each week we would like the children to complete two online learning tasks to help them improve their vocabulary knowledge. The children are very excited to do this.

Curriculum Learning

In English this half-term we will be focusing on two units of work: Non-chronological texts based on vehicles and a Poetry unit of work. Within this work we will continue to improve our reading skills, develop our grammar knowledge and gain confidence in writing.

In Maths, this half-term we are continuing to improve our addition and subtraction skills and apply this knowledge to reasoning and problem solving questions.

Other subjects we are learning this term include our new Geography unit: Our School, Our Village. Within this topic we are looking forward to going on a field trip around the village of Great Whelnetham.
